

Evaluation criteria

Your submission will be evaluated according to how well it does the following:

- Constructs an interesting proposition or set of propositions that have a clear focus and are well articulated (15%)
- Develops a coherent structure for addressing that proposition or those propositions (10%)
- Presents a core argument with a defensible methodology, exhibiting an awareness of the strengths and limitations of that methodology (25%)
- Presents appropriate literature and theoretical, historical, institutional or statistical material in a systematic manner (25%)
- Draws appropriate conclusions, identifying lessons to be drawn from the study for economic analysis and/or policy, as well as further possible lines of research (20%)
- Makes clear use of language (5%)
